DANGEROUS AND UNSIGHTLY PREMISES BYLAW AMENDMENT

BYLAW NUMBER 22A

A Bylaw to amend the Dangerous and Unsightly Premises Bylaw, Bylaw # 22, to enable the issuance of municipal offence tickets for offences against the bylaw.

This bylaw is made under the authority of the *Charlottetown Area Municipalities Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-4.1.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Stratford that the Dangerous and Unsightly Bylaw, Bylaw # 22, be amended as follows:

- 1. That paragraph 10(a) be amended by replacing the word "tis" with the word "this".
- 2. That section 12 be deleted and replaced with new section 12 as follows:
 - 12 Prosecution and Enforcement
 - a. The prosecution of offences under this Bylaw shall be in accordance with the Summary Proceedings Bylaw, Bylaw # 34; and
 - b. This Bylaw may be enforced and any breach thereof may be restrained by application by the Council to the Supreme Court of the Province of Prince Edward Island in accordance with subsection 139(3) of the *Charlottetown Area Municipalities Act* or any successor act or provision.
- 3. That paragraph 13(a) be deleted and replaced with new paragraph 13(a) as follows:
 - 13.a Any owner who fails to comply with all terms of any notice issued pursuant to this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalty set forth in Schedule A annexed hereto and forming part of this Bylaw and in default of payment of any fine imposed, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 60 days;
