1. Introduction

The Town of Stratford has a monument that is dedicated to veterans who served in World War I, World War II or Korea.

2. Names on the Monument

Veterans who served in World War I, World War II, or Korea and who lived in the Town of Stratford, or in the Stratford Area if their name is not recorded on another monument, are eligible to have their name recorded on the monument.

3. Process

Any person who is eligible can be nominated to have their name on the monument by contacting the town's Community Engagement Coordinator and submitting the information required to demonstrate their eligibility.

4. Approval

The Community Engagement Coordinator will determine eligibility based on the information submitted and approve or deny the request and, if approved, arrange to have the name added to the Monument.
