note 3 - 2008 RiNC project (\$62,500), electronic basketball backboards partnership (\$6000),

soccer field replacement partnership (50,000 funded partially through RiNC program)

- note 4 annual additions to sidewalk/trail/bike pathways, exact locations to be determined (new deal funding)
- note 5 core area development (new deal funding), possibly including a landscaping project for Town Centre property
