WHEREAS the sculpture of Michael Thomas is one component of the Diversity Fountain proposal which has received funds from the PEI 2014 Fund; and

WHEREAS a steering committee including the chairpersons of Heritage, Arts and Culture, and Diversity and Inclusion committees, as well as representatives from CADAC, and the Mi'kmaq Confederacy of PEI, and Director of Planning has been formed to coordinate the project; and

WHEREAS an advertisement of "Request for Proposals" was placed in the Guardian and the Town's website on September 21; and

WHEREAS Ten proposals were submitted to the Town by qualified proponents; and

WHEREAS in accordance with the announced evaluation criteria, the steering committee carefully reviewed, evaluated and scored all proposals and created the scoring/ranking table as follows:
