**WHEREAS** the sculpture of Michael Thomas is one component of the Diversity Fountain proposal which has received funds from the PEI 2014 Fund; and

**WHEREAS** a steering committee including the chairpersons of Heritage, Arts and Culture, and Diversity and Inclusion committees, as well as representatives from CADC, and the Mi'kmaq Confederacy of PEI, and Director of Planning has been formed to coordinate the project; and

**WHEREAS** an advertisement of "Request for Proposals" was placed in the Guardian and the Town's website on September 21; and

WHEREAS Ten proposals were submitted to the Town by qualified proponents; and

**WHEREAS** in accordance with the announced evaluation criteria, the steering committee carefully reviewed, evaluated and scored all proposals and created the scoring/ranking table as follows:
